

In the Matter of petition for Formation  
of Stege Sanitary District.

It appearing that in accordance with the certain orders made by this Board of Supervisors on the 17th day of March, 1913, and on the 7th day of April, 1913, directing that an election be held on Thursday, May 15th, 1913, within certain territory therein and hereinafter particularly described, for the purpose of determining whether the same shall become a Sanitary District in the name of "Stege Sanitary District", the notice of the election thereby ordered to be published in the "Richmond Daily Independent" a newspaper printed and published within the County of Contra Costa (there being no newspaper published within said proposed District) was duly published in the said newspaper the "Richmond Daily Independent" once a week for four successive weeks prior to the date of election, to wit: the 15th day of May, 1913, as appears by the affidavit of Octavia Norton on file herein, and that said notice of election thereby ordered to be posted in at least three public places within said proposed Sanitary District was duly posted for more than four successive weeks prior to the day of election as appears by affidavit of F.A.Kidd, on file herein, and that in accordance with said orders so made, published and posted, the election was duly held on Thursday, the 15th day of May, 1913, within said limits.

This Board on this 19th day of May, 1913, being the Monday next succeeding said election, having proceeded to canvass and having canvassed the votes cast at said election and upon said canvass it appears that there were 226 votes cast at said election, and that out of said total number of 226 votes cast, a majority of the votes cast, to wit: 205 votes were in favor of a Sanitary District and that 8 votes were cast against a Sanitary District, and that the following named persons received the number of votes set opposite their respective names for the several offices specified in said order and notices of election and herein set opposite their respective names, to wit:

Now, therefore, this Board hereby determines and finds that said election was conducted in all respects as in accordance with law and that a majority of the 226 votes cast at said election, to wit: 205 votes were in favor of a Sanitary District,

It is hereby ordered that the territory lying within the said limits and hereinafter particularly described be and the same is hereby ordered and declared



to be a duly established Sanitary District of the name of "Stege Sanitary District" and that the following named persons have received respectively, the highest number of votes to wit: the number of votes set opposite their respective names, for the several offices specified in said notice of election as the office to be filled at said election, be and they are respectively declared to be duly elected as such officers as follows, to wit:

The territory hereinbefore referred to is described as follows, to wit:

All that certain territory lying and being in the County of Contra Costa, State of California, and particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot Number sixty-eight (68) of the San Pablo Rancho, in Contra Costa County, California, as laid down and delineated on that certain map entitled "Map of the San Pablo Rancho, accompanying and forming a part of the Final Report of the Referees in Partition" and filed in the office of the Recorder of Contra Costa County California; thence southerly along the eastern boundary line of said Lot number sixty-eight (68) to the southerly boundary line of said Lot Number 68; thence along said last line and a direct extension thereof westerly to a line drawn parallel to and westerly one hundred and fifty (150)<sup>feet</sup> measured at right angles from the westerly line of San Pablo Avenue; thence along last said line parallel to San Pablo Avenue southerly to an intersection with a direct extension northerly of the westerly line of Lot Number sixty-one (61) San Pablo Rancho above mentioned; thence along last said extension and along the westerly boundary line of lot Number sixty-one (61) San Pablo Rancho, and along a direct extension southerly of the said westerly line of lot sixty-one (61) San Pablo Rancho, southerly to an intersection with a line drawn parallel to and one hundred and twenty-five (125) feet southerly from the southerly line of Cypress Street measured at right angles thereto; thence along said line parallel to and one hundred and twenty-five feet southerly from Cypress Street easterly to an intersection with a line drawn parallel to and one hundred and fifty feet (150) measured at right angles westerly from the westerly line of San Pablo Avenue; thence along said last line parallel to San Pablo Avenue southerly to an intersection with a line drawn parallel to and one hundred (100) feet measured at right angles northerly from the northerly line of Bay View avenue; thence along said line parallel to Bay View Avenue easterly to the westerly line of San Pablo Avenue; thence along last said line southerly to the northerly line of Lot thirteen (13) of the San Pablo Rancho; thence along said northerly boundary line of lot thirteen (13) San Pablo Rancho westerly to the easterly boundary line of the right of way of the Southern Pacific Railway; thence along said easterly boundary line of the Southern Pacific Railway right of way in a general southerly direction to the line dividing Alameda and Contra Costa Counties; thence along last said line easterly and along the line dividing Alameda and Contra Costa Counties, to the southeast corner of the San Pablo Rancho; thence along the eastern boundary line of the San



Pablo Rancho northwesterly to the northern boundary of Lot number sixty-five of the San Pablo Rancho; thence westerly along the northern boundary of Lot sixty-five (65) of the San Pablo Rancho to the point of beginning.

That the territory included within the foregoing boundaries comprises that part of the San Pablo Rancho bounded on the north by the northern line of Lot 65 of the San Pablo Rancho; on the west by the Richmond City Limits; on the south by the dividing line between Alameda and Contra Costa Counties; and on the east by the dividing line between the Rancho El Sobrante and the San Pablo Rancho and all situated in the County of Contra Costa, State of California.

The foregoing order is passed by the following vote of the Board, to wit:
